### National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week

*April 12-18, 2026*

**WHEREAS**, emergencies can occur at any time that require sheriff, fire or emergency medical services; and,

**WHEREAS**, when an emergency occurs the prompt response of sheriff's deputies, firefighters and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and,

**WHEREAS**, the safety of our sheriff's deputies and firefighters is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone the Combined Regional Communications Authority; and,

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and,

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our sheriff's deputies and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety; and,

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators of the Combined Regional Communications Authority have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and,

**WHEREAS**, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE PROCLAIMED** by the County Commissioners of Fremont County that the week of April 12 through 18, 2026, be National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in Fremont County, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our county and citizens safe.
