What This Dashboard Does

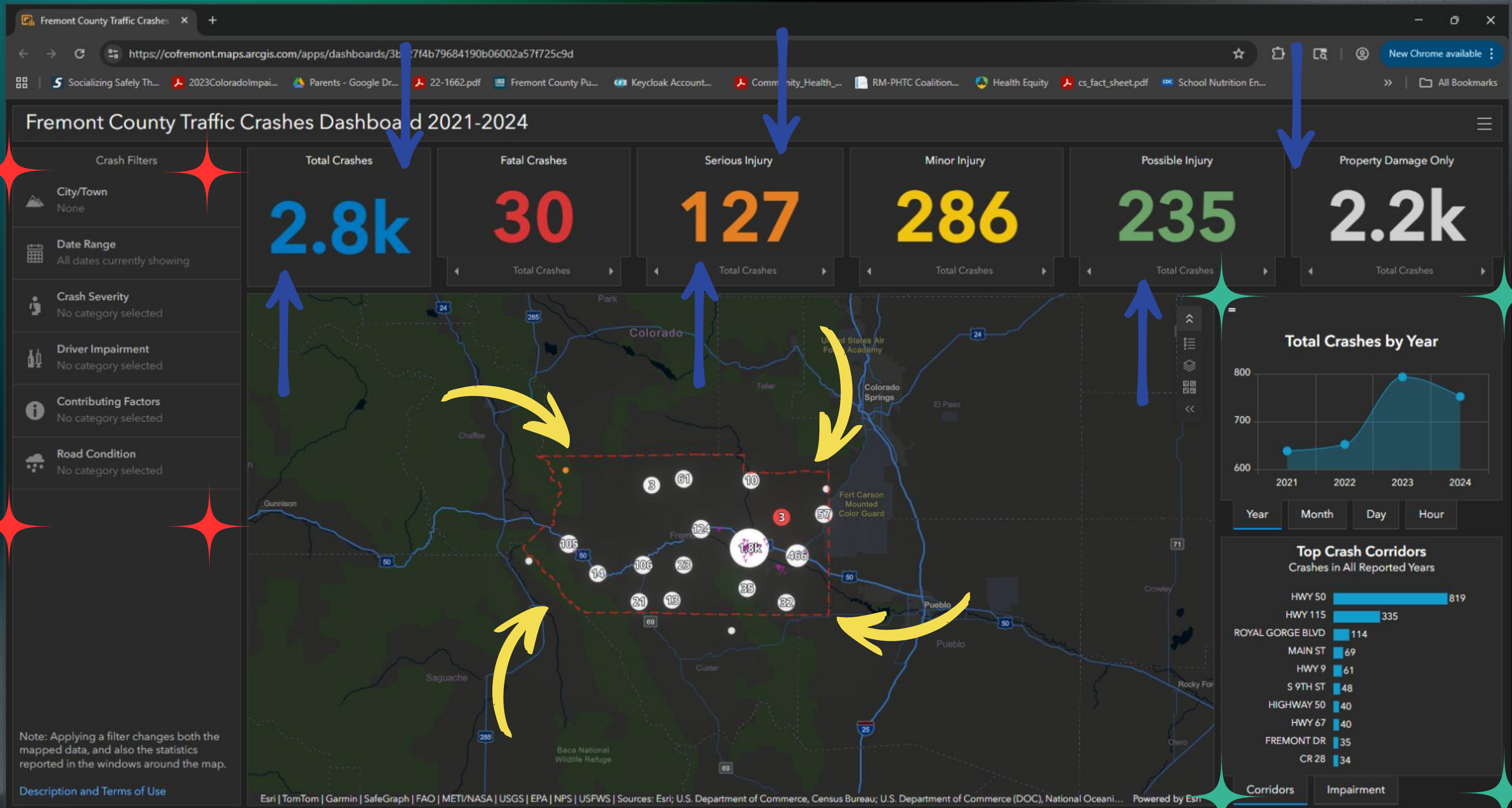
Tracks crash trends over time

Supports decision-making

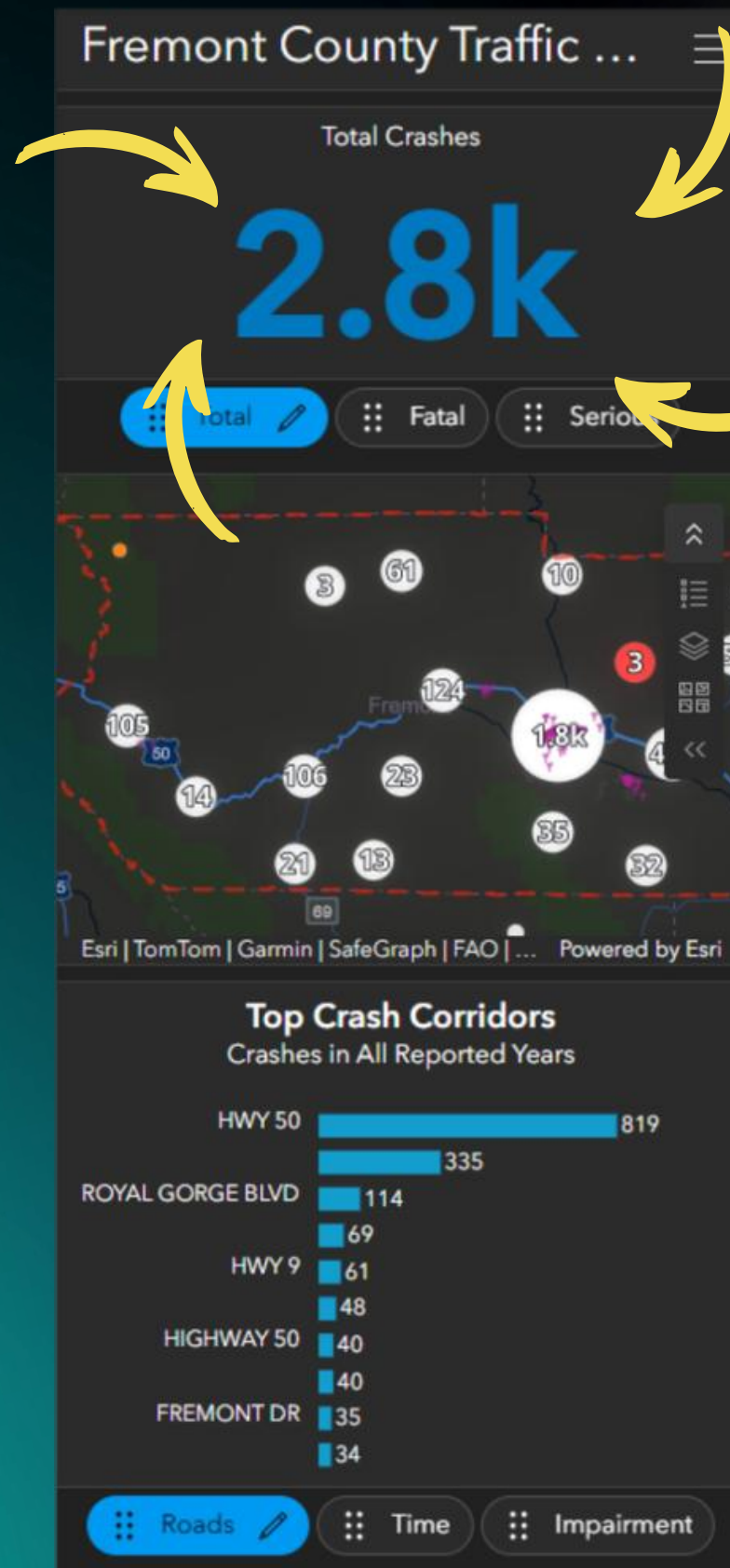
Dashboard Overview

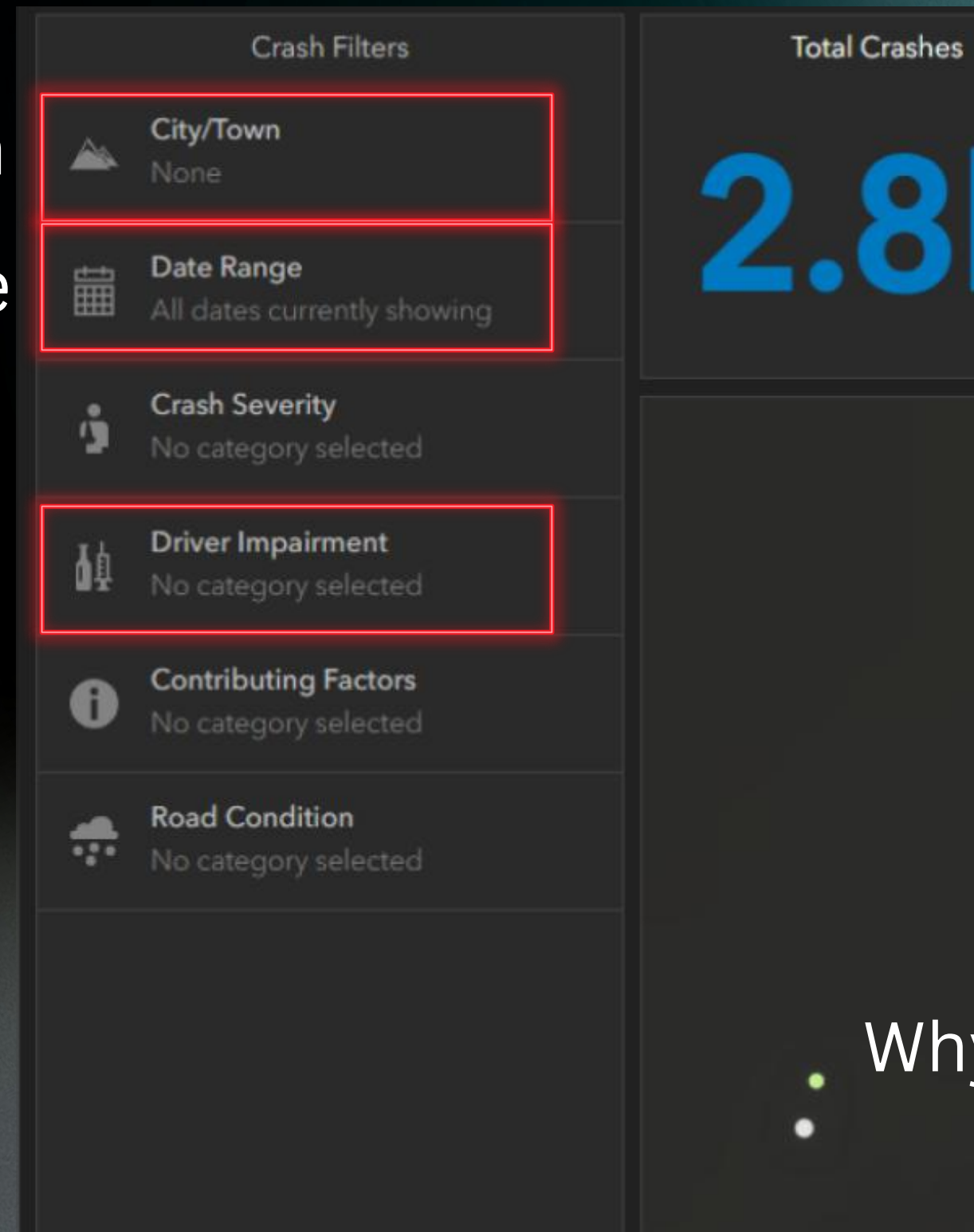

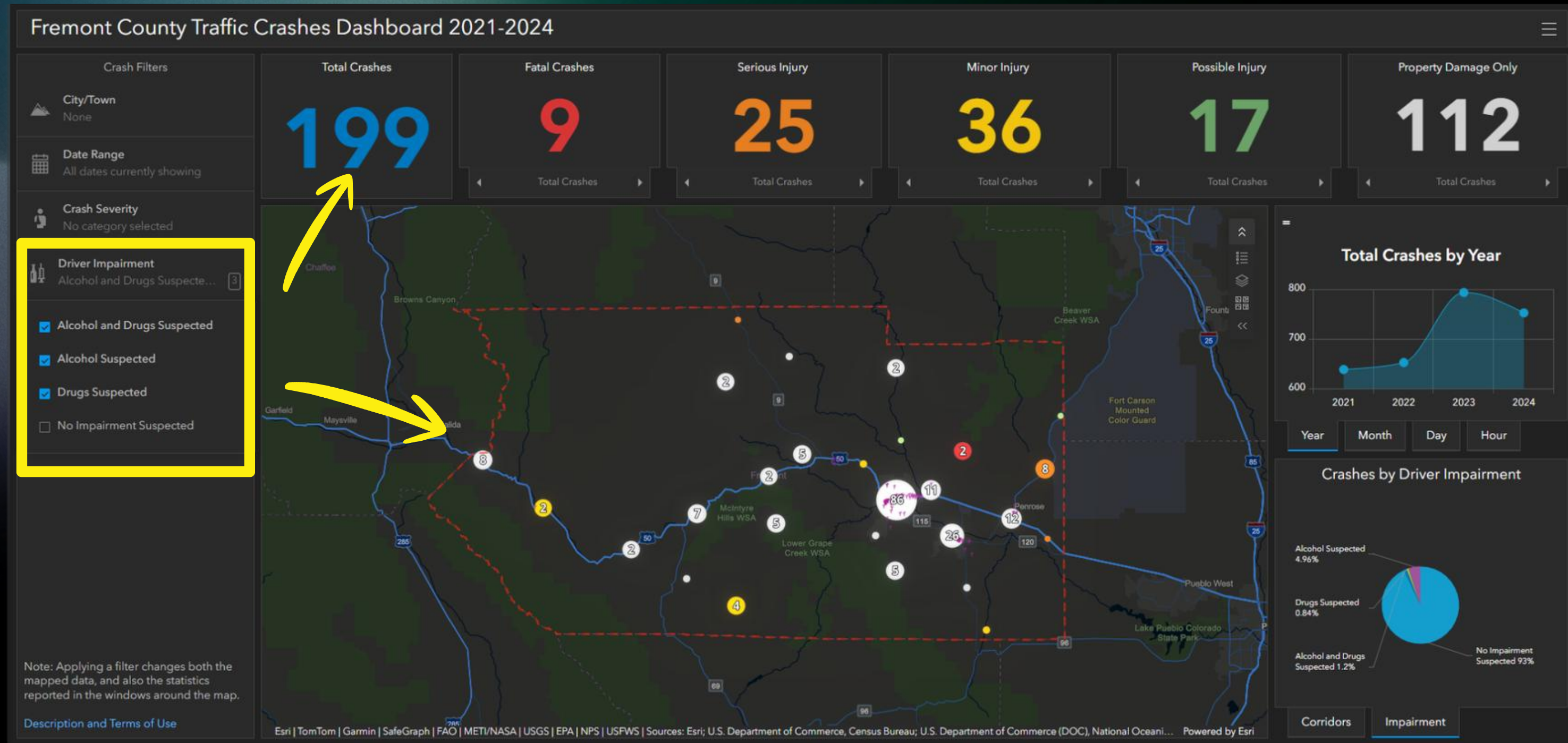
Analyze trends over time

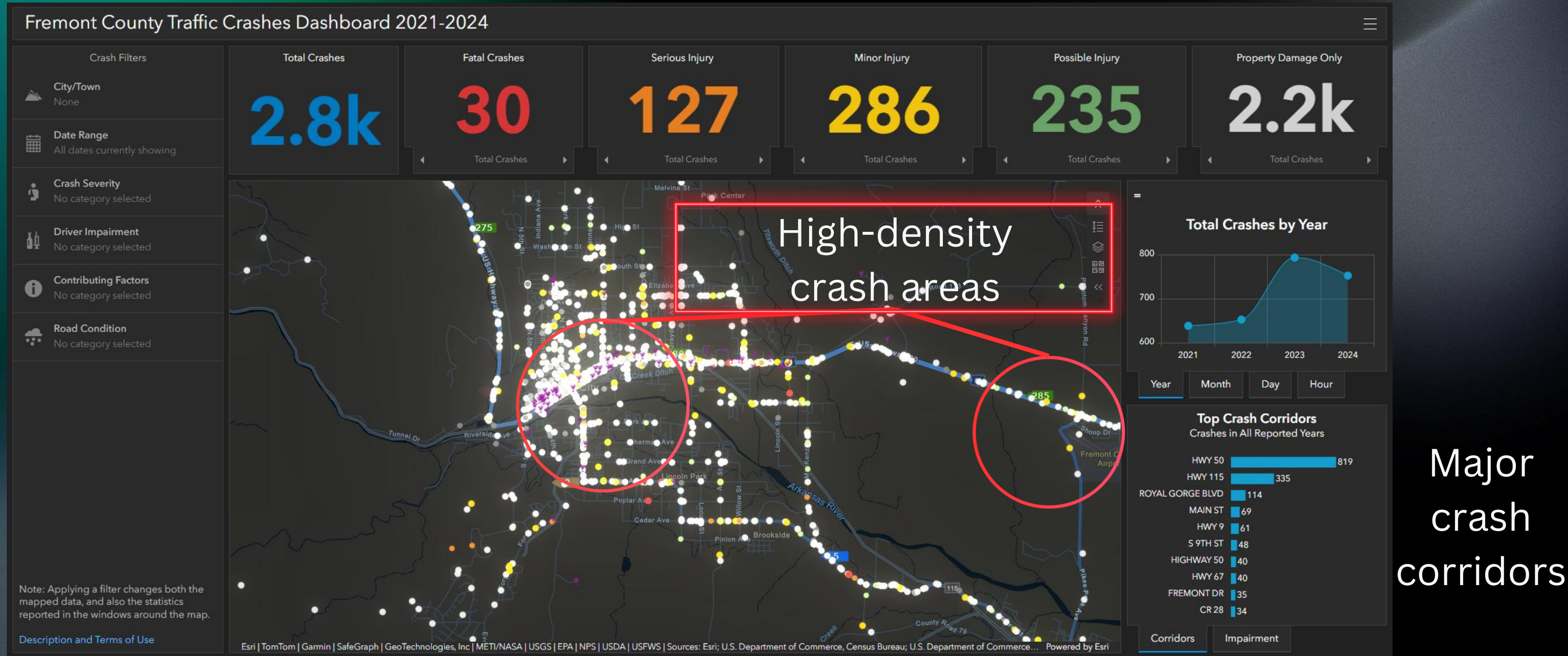
Impaired Driving Analysis



Filter Applied: Impaired Driving (Alcohol + Drugs)

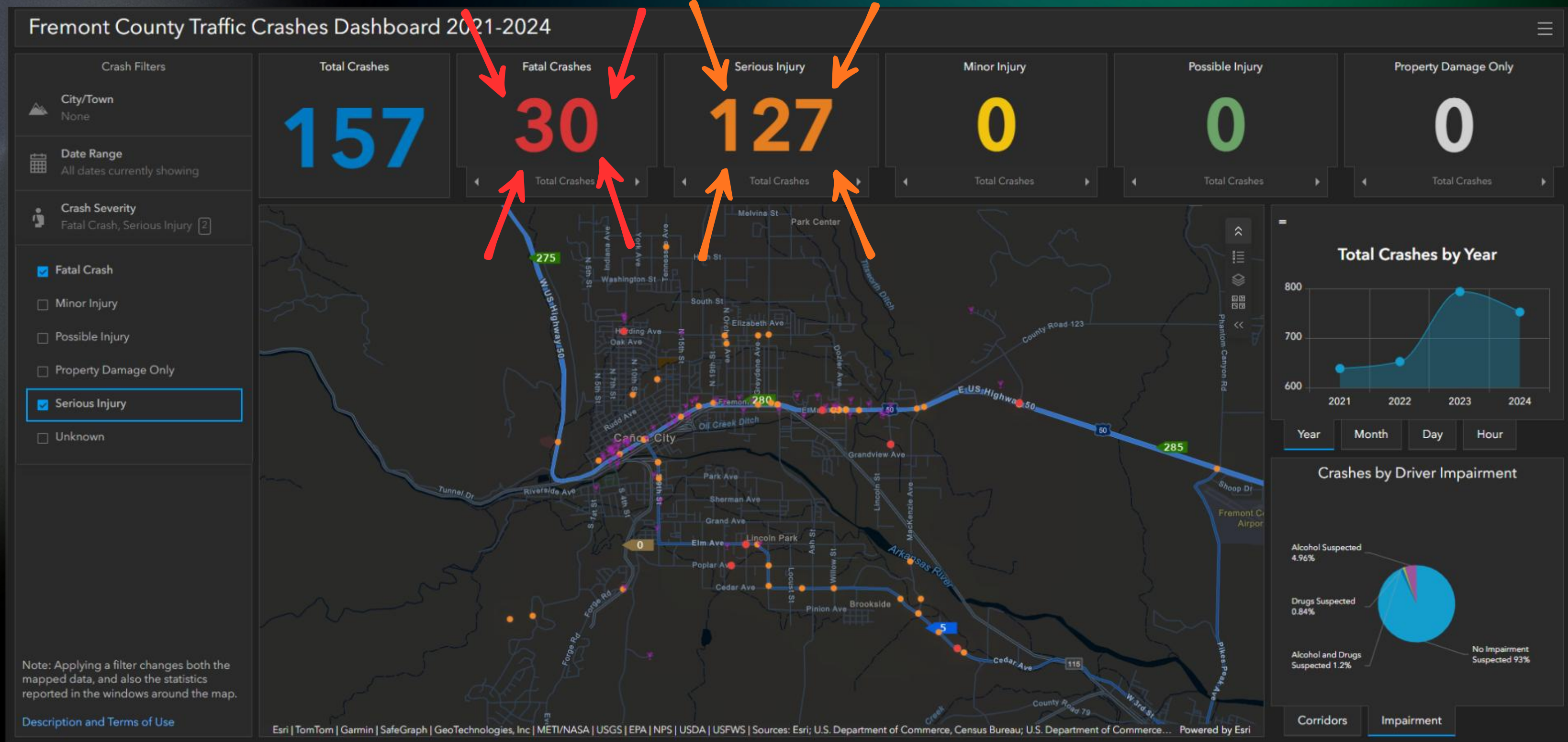
Why this matters: Supports DUI prevention strategies
