

NOTICE: COLORADO MEANS-TESTED PUBLIC BENEFITS



The Colorado Department of Human Services (CDHS) and the Colorado Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) provide this public notice identifying state-administered public benefit programs that are “means-tested.” A “means-tested” benefit is one where eligibility is based, in whole or in part, on an applicant’s income or financial resources. The following list of programs and sub-programs are considered means-tested public benefits:
