#### 1. PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:

- Previous (12-05-2018) Meeting Minutes were read and approved.

## 2. COUNTY REPORT (SUNNY BRYAN / DEBBIE BELL):

- New Dawson Hangar is waiting on Land Use Approval from the FAA.
- The 2013 Airport Master Plan is out of date and needs to be updated to reflect near-future desired development.
- The Board feels the need for more hangars
  - Wes Brandt said he receives 2 to 3 phone calls a day asking for hangar space.
     Brandt said that the Waiting List contains only about 15 individuals.
  - Question: Is the Waiting List first-com-first-serve?
  - Question: How quickly do hangars come available.
  - There seems to be a great deal of pent-up need for many more T-hangars.
  - Jim Wick said that the more hangars built will increase fuel sales revenue.
  - Board needs to discuss types of hangar designs needed.
- The County is negotiating to have Hangar #4 for State aircraft use.

# 3. AIRPORT MANAGER REPORT (WES BRANDT):

- Still working on Grants to resurface taxi ways A1 & A2.
- Fuel sales are low due to normal season.
- Doss Aviation desires to install an ADS-B receiver at the airport to allow them to monitor student aircraft flying within the airport's airspace.
- The count for airport traffic is provided by Doss Aviation and Fort Carson.
  - (Dan Meeks is not sure how other civilian traffic is counted.)

## 4. SAFETY (SKIP MOREAU):

- Skip has found unlocked hangars not secure.
- The airport has a fire truck (water & foam) but no one is educated on its operation.
- Confirm know how to Fire Extinguishers.
- Know who has First Aid / CPR training
- Ensure FBO First Aid Kit is adequate.
- The airport has not oxygen servicing.

# 5. AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT (LU TOXVARD):

- Self-Service Fuel and Bulk Fuel Sales were discussed.
  - Other nearby airports are selling for less.
  - Lu demonstrated to the county representatives iPad aviation apps that allow pilots to quickly select the lowest fuel prices along the route.
- Courtesy Car for transient pilots use was discussed.
  - County would like to see examples of how other counties deal with liability issues.

# 6. FINANCIAL (NO ASSIGNED BOARD MEMBER):

- Nothing discussed.
- Income Statement, 2018 Nov thru Feb not presented

## 7. NEW BUSINESS:

- Dick Baker removed as Airport Manager.
  - Wes Brandt is filling in as Acting Airport Manager.

  - Jim Wick was selected to represent the Board in reviewing applicants.
