Drainage and Storm Water Quarterly Inspection

All known inlets and outlets for culverts and all known detention ponds were visually inspected to determine whether they were properly functioning or obstructed/damaged and in need of repair. The descriptions serve to detail any necessary intervention.

<u>Item 1:</u> The majority of culvert inlets and outlets need to be cleared of debris and tumbleweeds. The following list represents the most urgent.

Culverts along the ditch that flows to the Eastern detention pond.



- The culvert at the gate of Skip's skydiving business.
- The culvert at the entrance of Skip's skydiving business.
- Culvert that runs across taxiway A2.
- Culverts at Hanger 22 (south and west ends).
- Culverts at Hanger 19.

<u>Item 2:</u> The following list is of culverts that need to be dug out.

• Culvert at hanger 25 is nearly filled with sand.



Culvert that crosses the Eastern most road on way to East detention pond.



Culvert at the gate before Skip's skydiving business.

<u>Item 3:</u> The following list is for the culverts that have crushed ends.

Culvert at hanger 24.



The North end of the Culvert on the Decker Dr. side of the Cole property.

<u>Item 4:</u> The silt fence limiting runoff on to Highway 67 needs some maintenance in various places. On next inspection the effectiveness of the silt fence will be

evaluated for possible removal.

<u>Item 5:</u> It is recommended that all diches on the airport property be burned or cleared to increase effectiveness. Mainly, the ditch that flows to the Eastern detention pond and the large ditch that flows to the Southern detention pond.

Conclusions:

All culverts and detention ponds should be cleared of tumbleweeds and debris. All items documented for maintenance should be remedied by the next quarterly inspection, although it is understood that some items may be ongoing.
