2022 Budget Strategy

- Provide quality services to Fremont County citizens
- Provide a fiscally responsible County budget
- Preserve County assets
- Maintain fund balance
- Address the increased requests and increased expenses

Overview of 2022 Revenues

- Projecting an increase of 16% in the Assessed Valuation from 2020 Assessment
- Estimating an increase in revenue of \$644,636 in General Fund, \$65,061 in Department of Transportation, \$206,740 in Department of Human Services, and \$24,570 in Airport Fund
- Projecting Retail Sales Tax to slightly decrease from 2021 estimated
- Projecting Auto Use Tax Collections to increase slightly from 2021 budget
- Projecting Construction Use Tax to decrease from 2021 budget

Overview of 2022 Expenses

- Proposing new salary scale to increase entry level pay
- Proposing annual step increases in accordance with salary scale
- No increase in health insurance premiums
- Addressing building improvement needs in various county owned buildings
- Keeping up with increased operational costs
- Building reserves to be used as match for bridge replacement grants
- Looking at grant opportunities to be used on various projects
- Unknown long term impacts of COVID 19


American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

- Fremont County will receive a total of \$9,292,165
- Currently reviewing preliminary guidance to determine eligible projects
- Received list of needs from departments
- Currently soliciting public input on use of funds


2022 Capital Projects

- Build Pavilion/Barn at Pathfinder Park


Property Tax revenues assessed from fiscal year 2015-2022 Budget



Retail Sales Tax 2015-2022 Budget




Auto Use Tax 2015-2022 Budget

General Fund Total Revenues 2015 to 2022 Budget






