RE: County Manager Report

The construction of the Pathfinder Park Community Center is continuing. We are waiting on the three-phase electric from Black Hills, which has put the project behind approximately three weeks. We are scheduled to take over the building the end of November.

The Commissioners and I have begun our meetings to discuss the 2022 budget requests. We will meet throughout this week and again in October to finalize the budget.

We are still going through the process of refinancing the 2013 Certificates of Participation. This will save the County approximately \$3 million in interest. We are scheduled to close on the COPs in October.

We currently have the replacement of the Administration Building Roof out to bid. For more information go to our website at <a href="https://www.fremontco.com">www.fremontco.com</a>. Upcoming projects include a remodel in the Motor Vehicle Division of the Clerk's Office and a remodel of some space at the buildings at 1901 East Main Street.
