A RESOLUTION EXTENDING ALL AMBULANCE SERVICE LICENSES WITHIN FREMONT COUNTY THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024

WHEREAS, ambulance services have historically been regulated by the County pursuant to C.R.S. §30-11-107(1)(q); and

WHEREAS, the County has adopted regulations and issued licenses authorizing the provision of ambulance services to and for the citizens of the County; and

WHEREAS SB22-225 transfers regulatory authority to the State of Colorado and requires ambulance service providers to obtain a license from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment to operate on and after July 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the County regulated system previously in place was efficient and effective and provided high quality and reliable emergency medical services to the citizens of Fremont County, and that extension of existing County issued licenses for such services through midnight on June 30, 2024, the date and time that County licensing authority expires, is reasonable and will promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Fremont County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR FREMONT COUNTY THAT ALL LICENSES PREVIOUSLY ISSUED BY THE COUNTY FOR THE PROVISION OF AMBULANCE SERVICES WITHIN FREMONT COUNTY BE AND ARE HEREBY EXTENDED THROUGH **MIDNIGHT ON JUNE 30, 2024.**
