Dear Mr. Victoria,

On March 31, 2023, Holcim – ACM Management, Inc. acquired 100% of the membership interest of Canon Dolomite Quarry, LLC. As part of the acquisition, Holcim-WCR, Inc. now owns equity in the following operating guarry with a Fremont County Conditional Use Permit (CUP):

 Canon Dolomite Quarry located at 50814 W Hwy 50, Canon City, CO 81215. The Canon Dolomite Quarry is currently operating under Permit No. 11-001. The CUP is currently held by Rocky Mountain Landscape Materials LLC.

We respectfully request that the Fremont County Board of County Commissioners transfer the current CUP ownership from Rocky Mountain Landscape Materials LLC to Holcim – WCR, Inc.

We understand the conditions detailed in Permit No. 11-001 and will adhere to all requirements in the existing permit. Furthermore, we understand that any proposed modifications or updates to Permit No. 11-001 will need to be approved by the Fremont County Board of County Commissioners. At this time, the only requested modification to Permit No. 11-001 is transfer of ownership.
