Re: Request for Transfer of Ownership - CUP 12-001

Dear Mr. Victoria,

On March 29, 2023, Tezak Heavy Equipment Co., Inc. converted from an S-corporation to a limited liability company, Tezak Heavy Equipment Co., LLC, as authorized by Colorado law at Colo. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 7-90-201. On March 31, 2023, Holcim – ACM Management, Inc. acquired 100% of the membership interest of Tezak Heavy Equipment Co, LLC. As part of the acquisition, Holcim-WCR, Inc. now owns equity in the following operating quarry with a Fremont County Conditional Use Permit (CUP):

 T.H.E. Aggregate Source Quarry (referred to as the Canon City Quarry) located at 201 Tunnel Drive, Canon City, CO 81212. The Canon City Quarry is currently operating under Permit No. 12-001.

We respectfully request that the Fremont County Board of County Commissioners transfer the current CUP ownership from Tezak Heavy Equipment Co., Inc. to Holcim – WCR, Inc.

We understand the conditions detailed in Permit No. 12-001 and will adhere to all requirements in the existing permit. Furthermore, we understand that any proposed modifications or updates to Permit No. 12-001 will need to be approved by the Fremont County Board of County Commissioners. At this time, the only requested modification to Permit No. 12-001 is transfer of ownership.
