## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES AND RATES FOR LEASES AND SERVICES AT THE FREMONT COUNTY AIRPORT

WHEREAS, §30-11-107(j), C.R.S. authorizes the board of county commissioners to construct, maintain and repair airports and landing strips for aircraft, to enter into leases, and to fix and collect charges or fees for the use of such airports and landing strips; and

WHEREAS, the Fremont County Airport Manager has presented the Board of County Commissioners for Fremont County with a proposed fee schedule for services and leases at the Fremont County Airport; and

WHEREAS, the proposed fees are consistent with the recent study of airport lease rates and fees for comparable airports and services around the State of Colorado, conducted for Fremont County by KH/Ken Lawson Enterprises, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Fremont County Airport fees on the attached schedule, seems fair and appropriate and are reasonably calculated to reimburse Fremont County for actual time and costs incurred in providing the services, leases and leased property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Fremont County and users of the Fremont County Airport to consolidate, update and adopt the Fremont County fee schedule for lease rates and other services at the Fremont County Airport.
