Friday, August 2, 2024 -The show starts at 11:00 a.m.

### **Swine, Sheep, Goat, and Bucket Calf Show**

Animals must be vet-checked and checked in at Pathfinder by 10 a.m. on August 2

Preregister by 4:00 p.m. Friday, July 28. Email entry forms to [beaverparkag@gmail.com](mailto:beaverparkag@gmail.com)

We will accept entries on the day of the show if the participant is showing an animal that is already at the fair.

Vet Check and check in Friday, August 2nd, 8:30 a.m.-9:30 a.m.

For kids between the ages 3 to 7 as of January 1, 2024, and currently living in Fremont County and a parent or legal guardian must be present.

### **Pee-Wee Bucket Calf Show**

1. One calf per exhibitor.
2. Bucket calves are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the completion of the show.
3. Calves must be born on or after January 1, 2024.
4. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control, and knowledge of the animal.

### **Pee-Wee Goat Show**

1. One goat per exhibitor. May be shown with a halter or collar. No intact males.
2. You may use a 4-H/FFA members goat if the member and parent agree to it.
3. Goats not entered in the Fremont County Fair are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the completion of the show.
4. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control, and knowledge of the animal.

### **Pee-Wee Sheep Show**

1. One sheep per exhibitor. May be shown with a halter or collar. No intact males.
2. You may use a 4-H/FFA members sheep if the member and parent agree to it.
3. Sheep not entered in the Fremont County Fair are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the end of the show.
3. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control, and knowledge of the animal.

### **Pee-Wee Swine Show**

1. One swine per exhibitor. No sows or intact males.
2. You may use a 4-H/FFA members swine if the member and parent agree to it.
2. Swine not entered in the Fremont County Fair are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the end of the show.
3. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control, and knowledge of the animal.

### **Pee-Wee Utility Goat Show**

1. One goat per exhibitor. It may be shown with a halter or collar. No intact males.
2. You may use a 4-H/FFA member's goat if the member and parent agree to it.
3. Goats not entered in the Fremont County Fair are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the completion of the show.
4. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control, and knowledge of the animal.
