MINUTES: Board Member McFall moved, duly seconded by Board Member Bell to accept the minutes of the March 30, 2021 meeting with no additions or deletions. Upon vote: Board Member Grantham, aye; Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Bell, aye. The motion carried.

AGENDA: There were no additions or corrections to the agenda requested. Board Member Bell moved, duly seconded by Board Member McFall to approve the April 27, 2021 meeting agenda. Upon vote: Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Grantham, aye; Board Member Bell, aye. The motion carried.

FINANCIAL/CASELOAD REPORT: Stacie Kwitek-Russell stated the HCPF allocation is now forecasted to be slightly overspent, but overall all allocations show being underspent due to receiving additional COVID funding. After discussion, Board Member McFall moved, duly seconded by Board Member Bell to accept the March financial and caseload reports. Upon vote: Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Bell, aye; Board Member Grantham, aye. The motion carried.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Stacie Kwitek-Russell provided the Board with a written report summarizing the last month's activity that has taken place within the Department. In addition to discussion from the topics in the report, Board Member Bell posed the question of how the County can invest in a long-term solution for homeless expenses from the next round of COVID funds. Stacie agreed to prepare recommendations. Then Stacie Kwitek-Russell mentioned she will be out of the office during the next meeting; the board approved Wanda Embrey-Goss, Agency Administrator, and Kim Rankin from the Department attending in her place. After a full discussion, Board Member Bell moved, duly seconded by Board Member McFall, to accept the monthly report. Upon vote: Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Bell, aye; Board Member Grantham, aye. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no Old Business to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS: Stacie Kwitek-Russell said TANF will be underspent this year and there will be approximately \$200k available to sell to other counties. She said a new contract has been signed with Green Thumb Initiative (GTI) for summer camps and there are other ideas on how to better utilize TANF dollars in the future. After discussion, Board Member McFall moved, duly seconded by Board Member Bell to approve selling up to \$200k in TANF. Upon vote: Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Bell, aye; Board Member Grantham, aye. The motion carried.

Director Kwitek-Russell then moved on to discuss current staffing needs at the Department. She provided a hand-out to those present with two phases for the staffing request. Phase One includes additional positions for Child Welfare and temporary positions with Medicaid. Phase Two includes an additional administrative position and two more Child Welfare caseworkers. There was a full discussion regarding the requests which included sustainability, available space, equipment, and anticipated timing for implementation. After Stacie explained the plan and answered all the questions Board Member McFall moved, duly seconded by Board Member Bell to approve Phase One of the staffing request. Upon vote: Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Bell, aye; Board Member Grantham, aye. The motion carried.

With there being no other business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 2:46 p.m.
