The Fremont County Board of Human Services (BOHS) met in Regular Session Tuesday, December 29, 2020 in Conference Room 207 at the Fremont County Administration Building, 615 Macon, Cañon City, Colorado. Chairman Payne called the meeting to order at 2:20 p.m. Those present included:

Also present: Brenda Jackson, Fremont County Attorney, Sunny Bryant, Fremont County Manager, Commissioner-Elect Kevin Grantham and Stacie Kwitek-Russell, Director, Department of Human Services (DHS).

<u>MINUTES:</u> Board Member Bell moved, duly seconded by Board Member Payne, to accept the minutes of the November 24, 2020 meeting with no additions or deletions. Upon vote: Board Member Bell, aye, Board Member Payne, aye. Board Member McFall abstained from voting. The motion carried.

FINANCIAL/CASELOAD REPORT: Stacie Kwitek-Russell stated expenses are back in line and caseloads appear to have stabilized in Eligibility. Following review and discussion of the financial and caseload reports, Board Member Bell moved, duly seconded by Board Member McFall to accept the November financial and caseload reports. Upon vote: Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Payne, aye. The motion carried.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Stacie Kwitek-Russell provided the Board with a written report summarizing the last month's activity that has taken place within the Department and current issues she's focusing on. The COVID shelter is full at the present time. She's meeting with RE-1 because there's a major struggle with some students not engaging when they are utilizing online virtual education options. She stated DHS will partner with the school districts to develop a position to provide outreach and resources to these students. RE-1 has agreed to be the agency employing the position. The Child Welfare 80/20 allocation will support 80% of the position and the school districts will fund the remaining 20% county portion. This outreach effort will help prevent child welfare getting involved. So far this month 15 children have been removed and placed, which has increased the child welfare workload. She also discussed there's an exception in CCCAP where additional hours will qualify for payment. The Special Projects Coordinator position is open and there are seven candidates. Vivian Simon has returned as an Adult Protection Caseworker.

After a full discussion, Board Member Bell moved, duly seconded by Board Member McFall, to accept the monthly report. Upon vote: Board Member McFall, aye; Board Member Bell, aye; Board Member Payne, aye. The motion carried.
