



Average Food Stamp Issuance Per Month 2008 - 2019






















Average Monthly Food Stamp Caseload 2008 - 2019

January has been a busy month at DHS. I have been particularly busy with proposed legislation that will impact the agency and those we serve. The following are some of the activities and projects I have been working on this month:

- The management team spent some meaningful time together developing goals for the new year. We also developed a new Mission for the agency. Both will be presented at the BOHS meeting.
- I participated in teleconferences to discuss multiple bills that are being proposed this legislative session:
 - o Behavioral Health Transparency
 - o Increase to Basic Cash Assistance
 - Child Support Pass Through changes
 - Family First Prevention & Services Act for Colorado (Funding Split)
- I was able to spend the majority of one day observing our Dependency & Neglect docket; it is always enlightening.
- I was pleased to have 13 visitors during my monthly Admin In-Office Day. The topics ranged from updates on the breast feeding coalition to secondary employment.
- Carrie Porter and I participated in multiple meetings with CDHS regarding the formula
 for distribution of three different funding sources for Prevention & Intervention funds
 for this year. We should be receiving written notice of final amounts very soon. We
 anticipate Fremont County DHS will have \$420,000 available to utilize for
 implementation, continuation or expansion of Family Engagement Meetings,
 Permanency Round Tables, Trauma Treatment, Kinship Supports, and Parents as
 Teachers.
- I participated in the second Early Childhood Sector Partnership meeting.
- I had several meetings with Judicial regarding best practices in D&Ns, Truancy, and Family Treatment Drug Court.
- I continue to participate in the Implementation Team for Built for Zero and Carrie Porter and Rochelle Reiter participate in the bi-weekly case conferencing. We have seen tremendous success with these new strategies already.
- I chaired the January Fremont Interagency Oversight Group meeting where the CCHS
 Link Crew presented their Kindness Campaign. It was inspirational! FIOG selected a
 logo from many options created by Logan Crumley. They also received a copy of the
 Danger Ranger comic book that Logan created. They have two weeks to provide
 feedback and then it will go to print.
- We continue to experience extreme barriers in our work due to system issues in CBMS and Trails. The systems are slow and have bugs that affect workload significantly. It has also, unfortunately, impacted our ability to meet timeframes resulting in decreased C-STAT scores. This is, however, a statewide issue.
