REQUEST: CUP 17-002 Tezak Pit #2

Request approval of a Conditional Use Permit, Department file #CUP 17-002 Tezak Pit #2, by Tezak Stone Aggregate Supply, Inc., Mike Tezak, owner for the property which is located on the south side of U.S. Highway 50, approximately 3 miles west of Colorado State Highway 69 at the intersection of U.S. Highway 50 and C.R. 37 (aka McCoy Gulch). The pit will be a surface mine producing sand, aggregate and rock products. Operation times will be Monday through Saturday 7a.m. to 7 p.m.. The site has been in operation sense 1980. A temporary batch plant has been located on the site for the U.S. Highway 50 improvements during the summer of 2017. The original CUP permit 95-4 expired on January 9, 2016. This application will bring the site and CUP in to compliance with the county regulations. The operation will require 2 to 3 part time employees year round and up to 15 short term employees during times of accelerated production or paving projects.
