5-518	This was a requirement in state regulations prior to Fremont County adopting Fremont County Body Art Regulations.	
	An onsite re-inspection was not conducted; however the owners attended the Fremont County Board of Health meeting on 1/28/14 and requested that Fremont County allow the same disposal requirements that are in effect in El Paso County, which takes a more reasonable approach than some other jurisdictions. The decision of the Board was to allow the following: only gauze or similar materials soaked or caked with blood or lymph, shall be discarded in the red bio-hazard bags, with those bags picked up and disposed of by an approved disposal company, typically the same company that also picks up and disposes of sharps. Sharps will continue to be disposed of in the red plastic sharps containers. Other waste items may be discarded in the regular trash. A contract from Healthcare Medical Waste Services, LLC, was provided for red bio-hazard bag pickup.	
	A revised Infectious Waste management plan was submitted on March 18, 2014. This is adequate but can be easily shortened and simplified by simply stating which waste item are disposed of in the red bio-hazard bags, which items are disposed of in the sharps container, and which items are disposed of in the regular trash.
