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

9A. Personal Belongings7.9.1 (A) - Children's Effects

Observation: Individual storage space is not provided for the storage of coats, hats and other personal articles. Coats and jackets are thrown in a pile. Separate children's effects from each other to help reduce disease transmission. Discussed during inspection.

10B. Demonstration of Knowledge7.10.2 (A) - Demonstration of Knowledge

Observation: Staff does not know when handwashing is required. Staff stated children wash hands before coming into classroom. Staff and children are required to wash hands upon arrival for the day and after breaks, before eating or handling food, after the restroom, after coming in from outdoors, cleaning or handling garbage and at any time the hands have become soiled.

7.10.3 (E) - Hand Washing Supervision

Observation: Hand sanitizer gel or wipes are used in place of hand washing. Hand sanitizer is used after crafts when hands become sticky. Hand sanitizer can be used in addition to handwashing but not instead of handwashing.

Staff do not supervise children's handwashing and assure adequacy of the procedure. Per staff, children are supposed to wash hands prior to entering the classroom as they walk down the hallway and pass restroom. There is no supervision of if handwashing is done.



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7.10.5 (A) - Restrictions


Observation: Facility uses Bactive as sanitizer. Bactive is not approved for use as a sanitizer in child care facilities. Child care sanitizers must have designation for food contact surface sanitization and not require a final rinse step. Discussed during inspection, easiest option would be to ask school for use of their sanitizer. The waxie sanitizer the school uses would cover the requirements for child care sanitizers.
