- 8C: 7.8.1 (C) Correct By: 02/02/2021 Drinking water is not readily accessible to children while the facility is operating. Different options were discussed with the director. Submit verification of correction by 2/2/21.
- 10E: 7.10.5 (D) (1) Working containers of sanitizers are not labeled with contents and intended use. Director properly labeled spray bottle with sanitizer to include the intended use, corrected.
- 10F: 7.10.6 (E) Working containers of disinfectants are not labeled with contents and intented use. The director properly labeled the spray bottle with disinfectant to include the intended use, corrected.
- 10F: 7.10.6 (D) Correct By: 02/02/2021 Disinfectants are not mixed and used in accordance with manufacturer's labeled instructions. Provide training to staff on the proper mixing of bleach and water for disinfecting. Submit verification of correction by 2/2/21.
- 14B: 7.14.2 (E) Correct By: 02/02/2021 Sanitizers, disinfectants, cleaning and other compounds intended for use on food contact surfaces, toys and body contact surfaces are used in a way that leaves a residue. The sanitizing solution measured 1500 ppm. This was corrected by the director remixing the solution within the approved range of 50-200 ppm.
- Clorox wipes are being used on tables and toys without rinsing with water after. Training is needed for all staff. Submit verification of correction by 2/2/21.

General Comments

Today's inspection was conducted virtually with Amy Gammel (CDPHE) and Denise Santilli. Compliance with current public health orders (PHO) was assessed. All PHO elements were being implemented appropriately. It is strongly recommended that children 3 and older wear masks. It is also recommended to remove the number of toys in the classrooms to make daily cleaning and sanitizing more manageable.

The radon level is above the EPA recommended action limit of 4.0 pCI/L. It is recommended that the guidance provided at https://cdphe.colorado.gov/child-carehealth-regulations be followed to minimize the risk of radon for children and staff.
